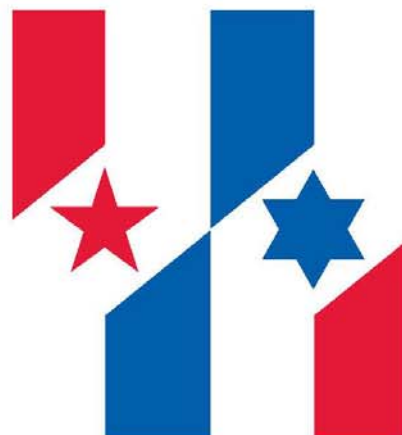

Widely recognized as one of the nation's leading political analysts and commentators, Kristol regularly appears on *FOX News Sunday* and *FOX News Channel*. He was a columnist for *TIME* magazine and *The New York Times*, and now writes an occasional column for *The Washington Post*.
