

BLUE J'S SUMMER CAMP 2024

What are the camp dates? (Please note there is no camp on July 4)

- **Blue J's Camp:** June 10-July 26
- **Cool Camps:**
 - Archaeology: June 10-June 14
 - Robotics and Coding: June 10-June 14
 - Cheer: June 10-June 14
 - Basketball Week 1: June 10-June 14
 - Basketball Week 2: July 15-July 19
 - Basketball Week 3: July 22-July 26
 - Musical Theater Camp: June 17-July 12

What are the hours?

- Half Day for 2-year-olds only: 8:30-12:30
- Full Day for all camps, including full-day 2-year-olds: 8:30-3:30
- Early Care: 8:00-8:30 am, \$20 fee per day
- After Care: 4:00-5:00 pm, \$40 fee per day

NOTE: We offer half or full day for the 2-year-olds only

What are the registration fees?

- \$535 per week (\$400 for half day)
- \$428 the week of July 4 (\$320 for half day)
- 15% discount if a camper registers for all 7 weeks - \$3095 (\$2405 half day)

What are the ages for regular Blue J's Camp?

2-year-olds by September 1, 2024, to 3rd grade

What does a typical day of Blue J's Summer Camp look like?

- Arrival: 8:30
- Activities start at 9:00
- Campers participate in STEAM, Art, Music, Water Play, Makerspace, Cooking, Yoga.
- Swim is only for the 3s, 4s, K and 1st
- Lunch is included
- Dismissal: 3:30 (must be picked up by 4 pm unless signed up for After Care)
- Arrival and Dismissal: Carpool only
- Field trips for K and up
- Camp Shows on Wednesdays
- Shabbat and Carnival on Fridays

What is the capacity per bunk, and what are the ratios?

- 2-year-olds: 12 campers with two counselors

- 3 and 4-year-olds: 15 campers with two counselors
- K-3rd grade: 20 campers with two counselors

Do the children nap or rest during the day?

- 2-year-olds nap from 12:30 to 2:30
- 3-year-olds nap or rest from 12:30 to 1:30

Do the campers need to bring lunch?

- Lunch is included with camp tuition and is provided by Miami Market Place, LLC.
- Campers can bring their lunch; it must be kosher style and nut-free

What about allergies?

- Campus nut-free
- Allergy aware
- Campers with allergies must provide an action plan and allergy treatment. In case of needing an Epi-Pen or an Avi-Q, parents need to provide 2 (one that travels with the camper and one that stays in the nurse's office)

What is the policy for potty training?

All children entering the 3s Level (or above) must be fully potty trained. Children in our 2s levels who are not potty trained must provide diapers, wipes, and diaper cream (labeled with the child's name). Pull-ups are NOT allowed.

What is the policy for applying bug repellent or sunscreen at camp?

Counselors can only apply sunscreen and bug spray to the children if the form on Shul Cloud is signed. Please send bug repellent and bug spray labeled with your child's name.

What are the Cool Camps?

- Robotics and Coding: June 10-June 14
- Cheer (2 weeks - Week 6 and 7): July 15-26

What is Musical Theater Camp, and what are the dates?

- Musical Theater Camp (Weeks 2 thru 5): June 17-July 12
- Musical Theater campers spend most of their time in the Performing Arts Center, learning their parts and rehearsing for the show.
- Our campers take charge of crafting their costumes, and bringing the stage to life with personally designed scenery.
- Campers participate in other activities like STEAM, Art, Water Play, Makerspace and Cooking,
- Musical Theater Camp Show: July 12
